
NORPLEX POOL REOPENS MAY 8**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

THOMPSON, May 4, 2017 – Following the events of April 23, the Norplex Pool is scheduled to open to the public on Monday, May 8, 2017.

Norplex Pool programming will resume as normal, with the exception that the facility will be closing an hour early every evening for the first week (May 9 -14).

Immediately following the incident, the Norplex pool was closed, and investigations were undertaken by multiple agencies, including the RCMP, Manitoba Public Health, and the City of Thompson. An inspection conducted on April 29 by Manitoba Public Health has cleared the facility for reopening as per Manitoba Regulation 132/97.

As the City of Thompson continues its investigation into the incident, City Mayor Dennis Fenske states that the pool is prepared to resume operations safely.

“Safety is paramount for the City of Thompson, for the families that use our facilities as well as the employees who serve them,” says Fenske. “We have full confidence in our facilities and our staff.”
