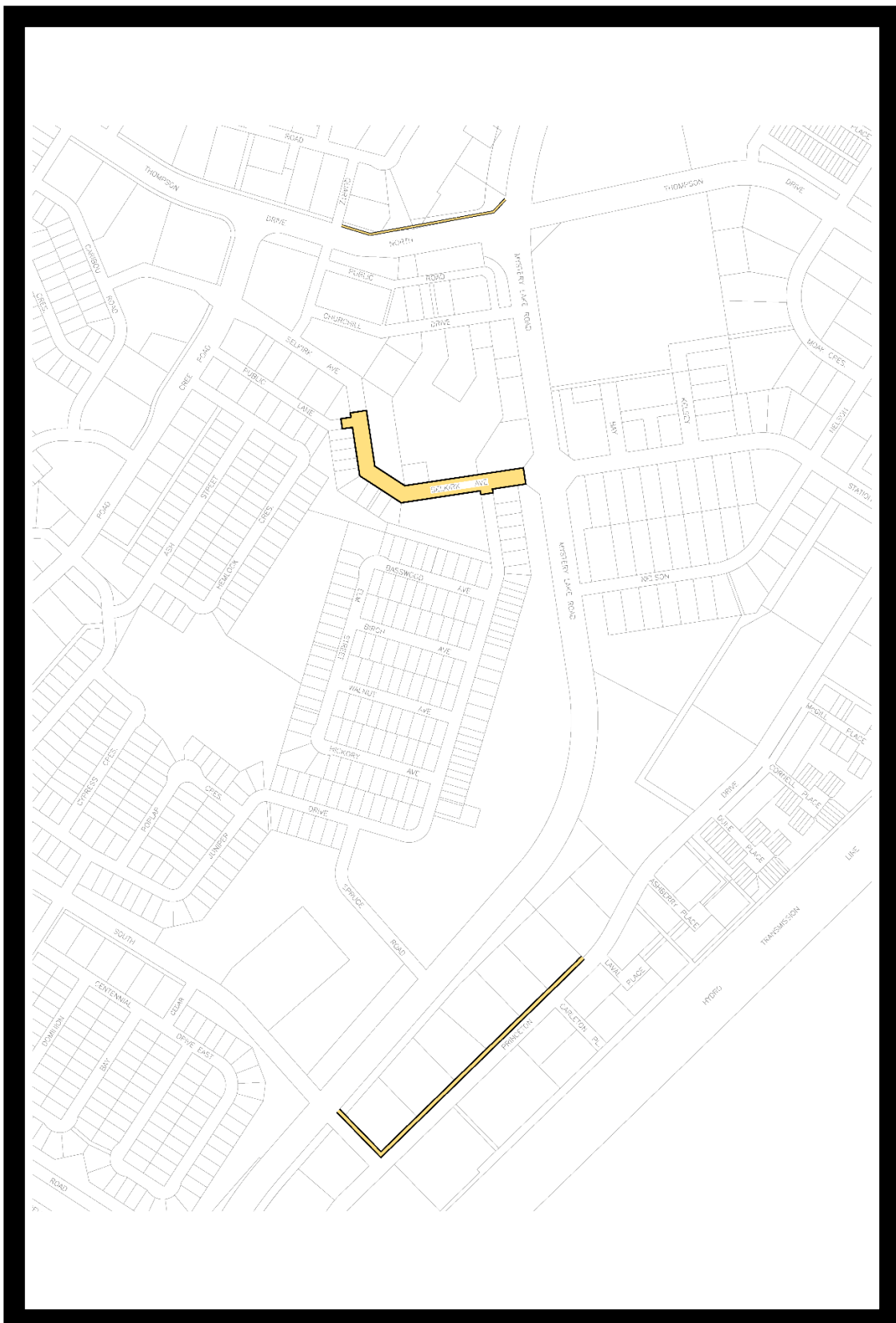
Construction of Princeton Drive Multi-Use Pathway & Reconstruction of Selkirk Avenue

Expected Start Date: July 2017

Expected Completion Date: October 2017

The City of Thompson will reconstruct Selkirk Avenue (between Public Lane and Mystery Lake Road). There will be a Multi-Use Pathway installed on the west side of Princeton Drive from Mystery Lake Road and continuing north on Princeton Drive, and sidewalk renewal will be conducted along Thompson Drive North from Quartz to Mystery Lake Road.

Project Details

This project involves:

- Reconstructing the roadway on Selkirk Avenue from Public Lane to Mystery Lake Road;
- Construction of Multi-Use Pathway along west side of Princeton Drive starting at Mystery Lake Road continuing north along Princeton Drive;
- Sidewalk renewal along north side of Thompson Drive North starting at Quartz to Mystery Lake Road;
- Restoration of areas disturbed during construction.

Some people may have planted landscaping, fences, irrigation systems or other physical features in front of their home/building which are within the City property limits. These may be in the way of the construction. In such cases, residents/businesses are advised to remove these items prior to the beginning of construction in order to avoid unnecessary damage. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.

Disruptions during Construction

In order to complete the necessary road and sidewalk work in a safe manner, it will be necessary to reduce or close traffic lanes and restrict parking. Access to driveways will be interrupted from time to time during construction. Local access and emergency traffic will be maintained at all times. The contractor is obligated to notify residents and businesses of any temporary driveway closures.

During construction of Selkirk Avenue, Selkirk Avenue will be closed in sections to ensure access to residents and businesses. Traffic will be detoured down Juniper Drive as well as Public Lane during various stages of construction.
