


2025 Budget Highlights

- Municipal General Levy Increase of 2%
 - -Mill rate of 27.53 Mills
 - The 2% increase will go towards Public Safety initiatives
- Business Tax rate remains at 3.99%
- Special Levy remains at \$91.91 (for Water, Storm and Sewer Service Line residential repairs)






2025 Property Taxes - Thousands

- Economic Development Services








Debt Outstanding, End of 2025










Reserve Balances Ending


